SYSTEM OVERVIEW

The SRS “SENTINEL” Wireless System is designed not only to satisfy SRS applications, it similarly offers full compliance with the communication requirements of SDA/NDIS High Physical Support Accommodation. It allows both mobile or fixed location wireless call buttons to deliver preprogrammed messages directly to a selection of one or more Alphanumeric Pagers and/or Annunciator displays.

Robust waterproof wireless Pendants also allow Residents to call for help from their bed, wheelchair or within the shower cubicle. If necessary waterproof call-points may also be supplied to suit wet and external locations.

The typical wireless range for a Pendant or Call-Point exceeds 150M in free space. However, where longer range is required or the need to avoid range blocking brick walls or concrete floors it's possible to include low cost range extenders (Repeaters).

A major benefit of this system is its ‘Plug-and-Play’ design concept. This means that all items are pre-programmed to suit the client's requirements and everything will operate correctly without adjustment as delivered.

This also means that there is no requirement for intermediate equipment or cable installation unless preferred.

The system uses the protected International POCSAG wireless Paging technology as used extensively within Hospitals and Age Care facilities.

An “SRS Sentinel” system may include one or more LED full colour Annunciator displays with their adjustable volume tone alerts.

The choice of call-points include ‘Call’ [with cord pendant socket], ‘Assist’ and ‘Emergency’ each suitable for fixed or surface mount.

Low battery reporting is provided however, to avoid using consumable batteries call-points can operate from an external 12v dc supply or via 12v plug-packs as would also be necessary for a Repeater.

Of local design and manufacture there is no practical limitation to the number of Pendants, Call-Points, Pagers, Repeaters or Annunciators that may be included within a system.
